Fund Balance: \$(1,350,000)

- Increased \$147,000
 Revenue: \$262,000
- Applications: 70 (-44%)
- Renewals: 260 (-18%)
 Evponditures: \$115,000



Significant Highlights


- Revenue increased 61% as expected, due to the fee FY2023 increase.
- Overall costs decreased primarily due to a decline in HELMS obligations, the use of one-time funding to support credentialing backlogs, and lower than expected legal and attorney general costs.
- These cost savings were offset by additional staff time charged due to an office reorganization.
