Similac Total Comfort	Powder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Calories: 20 calories per fl oz Milk-based, partially hydrolyzed protein, reduced lactose. Indication(s): Fussiness and gas due to lactose sensitivity. Notes: Option for infants who have difficulty tolerating other milk-based formulas.
