Source water protection is the first barrier to provide safe and reliable drinking water to communities by reducing the risk of contamination and decline in supply.

The Source Water Protection Local Assistance Grant provides funding for watershed and wellhead projects that protect public drinking water sources. We're updating grant guidelines and seeking feedback from our tribal partners on what projects we should prioritize and how we can make our funding easier to access, especially in communities most impacted by water quality and quantity concerns.
