- Renewals: 373 (+6%)

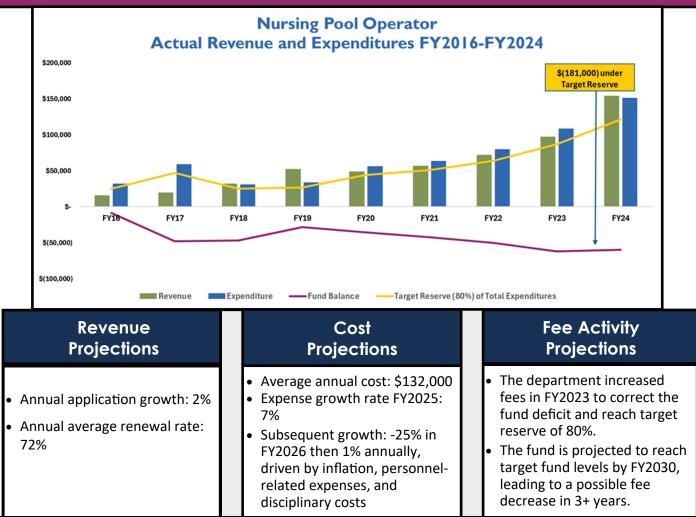
Expenditures: \$152,000

Significant Highlights

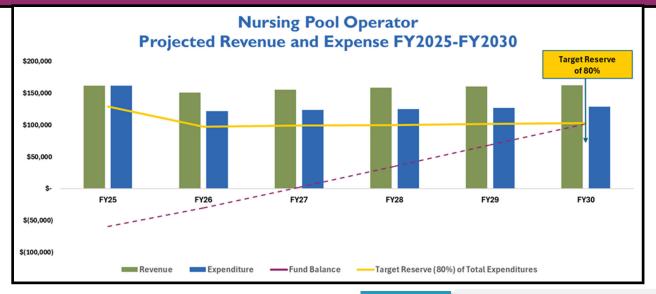
- Revenue increased 58% per the 2023 fee change to address the deficit.
- Overall, costs increased 42%, primarily due to the program's one-time purchase of new software for report generation. Costs are expected to return to 2023 levels.
- Disciplinary costs decreased due to reduced Attorney General activity.
