

# Public Notification and Meeting Announcement for Out-of-Network Health Care Charges (balance billing) for ground ambulance services

#### CR-102 for WAC 246-976-260 & WAC 246-976-270

#### Rulemaking

The Department of Health's Office of Community Health Systems officially filed a CR-102 with the Office of the Code Reviser on **June 24, 2025** to open WAC 246-976-260 & WAC 246-976-270 Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care. **The WSR number is 25-14-020.** 

The Out-of-Network Health Care Charges (balance billing) for ground ambulance services rules establish a requirement to comply and enforce balance billing for ground ambulance services.

The Department of Health (department) is conducting rulemaking in response to new legislative requirements under Substitute Senate Bill (SSB) 5986 (chapter 218, Laws of 2024) regarding Out-of-Network Health Care Charges (balance billing) for ground ambulance services. The department is proposing amending sections in WAC 246-976-260 – Licenses required & WAC 246-976-270 – Denial, suspension, revocation.
