



Outstanding Surface Water Treatment Plants

We evaluated the 2024 performance of 55 rapid-rate surface water treatment plants in Washington. Thirty-seven plants met optimization goals for particle removal and had no regulatory violations. By optimizing water quality produced by their existing facilities, these utilities perform above national regulatory standards—and provide better public health protection to their customers.
