Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners, and Professionals:

In accordance with chapter 43.376 RCW, the Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989, and DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure, we are providing information on the allocation of Tribal Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) funds for Budget Period 2 (BP2), covering July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

The Department of Health (DOH) has received a partial award from the Centers for Disease and Prevention (CDC) for Tribal PHEP funding. Accordingly, Tribes will receive an initial allocation of \$28,517.00 out of the full \$39,602.00 award. The remaining \$11,085.00 is expected later in the performance period. Once those funds are available, DOH will promptly issue an amendment to distribute the balance.

DOH is committed to transparency with our Tribal partners in hopes to maintain positive relations during this unprecedented time.
