Display outside door. At patient discharge, remove sign AFTER room is terminally cleaned.

FOR USE WITH CONDITIONS SUCH AS (refer to facility policy):

- Multi-drug resistant organisms (MDRO) and pathogens of epidemiological concern as determined by Facility Policy.
- CPOs, XDROs, VRSA, CRAB, C. auris.

ENSURE TO FOLLOW MANUFACTURERS INSTRUCTION FOR CLEANING SUPPLIES

 Ensure that proper PPE is worn for pathogen exposure <u>AND</u> any chemical exposure from cleaning supplies.

LINEN & WASTE MANAGEMENT

 Bag linen in patient's room. Avoid excessive handling and do not shake linen. For biohazard waste, follow Category B Medical Waste guidelines.

DISINFECT ANYTHING LEAVING ROOM

 Carts, cell phones, sharps containers, bed, wheelchair, etc. are required to be disinfected prior to leaving room.

ROOM CLEANING

- Refer to policy for timing and/or additional disinfectants.
- Enhanced cleaning procedures (e.g., high touch points, hourly, methodology) with addition of privacy curtain changes per hospital procedure.
- Refer to policy for terminal cleaning.

EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

- Minimize the number of items that are taken into the room. Ideally
- Only essential equipment and supplies in the room.
- Use dedicated/disposable equipment when available.
- · Maintain abundant supplies of consumables.
- Clean and disinfect reusable equipment/patient's room with disinfectant per facility policy.

LAB SPECIMENS/BLOOD TESTS:

- Bring in only the supplies needed to collect ordered samples.
- Exterior of specimen containers will be wiped down, then specimens double-bagged and bag wiped prior to leaving room.

Discontinue precautions per Facility Policy.

Sign to be removed by Environmental Services after precaution discontinuation and room cleaned.
