Supervised Experience

Supervised Experience must be:

- In direct treatment of persons with a mental disorder
- Gained under the supervision of a mental health professional who can independently assess and diagnose within the scope of practice of their credential
- Obtained after the completion of their degree or through an internship or practicum that is part of their degree program requirements
- Obtained under a credential to practice counseling or through a supervised internship or practicum
- Supervised experience earned out-of-state may be considered if:
 - The applicant held a credential in that state that was substantially equivalent to a counselor or MHP; and
 - Supervised experience met all other requirements above.

Coursework Identification

- The department uses course titles to identify course relevance to the knowledge areas (Certified AAC) or the identified course list(Licensed AAC.
- If the title and/or topic of the course is unclear, applicants are encouraged to submit supplemental documentation demonstrating its connection/relation to the knowledge area.

Supplemental documentation may include

- course syllabi
- course descriptions
- letters from instructors
- Courses will only be counted once.

Certified AAC requirements

Bachelors in 5 years supervised experience the social sciences CAAC Specified **Employment with** Coursework approved agency

Certified AAC coursework

You must satisfy coursework requirements by one of the following 2 ways:

- If your bachelor's degree is in any of the following, your degree alone satisfies the coursework requirements necessary for the credential:
 - psychology
 - social work
 - behavioral healthcare

- OR -

2. 4 total courses from 2 separate knowledge areas.

 - Counseling individuals
 - Counseling couples and families
 - Counseling groups

2. 5 total courses from an identified course list.

Legacy Provisions

Certified AAC: Applicant must have a bachelor's degree in counseling or one of the social sciences and all 5 years of supervised experience completed by July 1, 2025.

Licensed AAC: Applicant must have been previously designated as a mental health professional before July 24, 2023.

Acceptable designations include

- certificate or letter from the Department of Social and Health Sciences,
- letter from the Department of Health
- attestation/verification from behavioral health agency indicating designation.

*Applicants who meet legacy provision requirements must apply before July 1, 2027
