## First compliance date: Feb. 1, 2023

#### **Starting Feb. 1, 2023**


- Wraps
- · Plates
- Food boats
- · Pizza boxes



### Second compliance date: May 1, 2024

#### **Starting May 1, 2024**

- Bags and sleeves
- Bowls
- Flat serviceware, including items like plates and trays
- Open-top containers, including items like french fry cartons and food cups
- Closed containers, including items like clamshells




#### How to comply

**Food packaging manufacturers** must submit this Certificate of Compliance.

**Manufacturers** that make food packaging items on the banned list must develop and keep this certificate.

**Businesses** that purchase any of the above products can ask the manufacturer for their certificate of compliance.
