On behalf of Shriners Hospitals for Children (Shriners), and consistent with WAC 246-310-080, please accept this letter of intent for Shriners to establish an ambulatory surgery center (ASC) in Spokane County. The following information is provided to comply with the requirements of WAC 246-310-080(1):

A. Description of the Services Proposed:

Shriners proposes to establish an ASC in Spokane County. The ASC will be located at the site of the current Shriners Hospital in Spokane and will include two operating rooms and one procedure room.

B. Estimated Capital:

The estimated capital expenditure for the ASC is \$494,519.

C. Description of Service Area:

The primary service area for this project is the Spokane Secondary Health Services Area. In addition to the primary service area, the ASC will also serve a larger regional service area including the entirety of Eastern Washington and contiguous Idaho and Montana.
