Expired Vaccines

Nuvaxovid (Sanofi/Novavax) COVID-19

- No shelf-life extension was granted for this vaccine and all remaining doses expired on December 31, 2025
- Remove any expired product from your storage units
- Follow the [Returns Process](#) in the IIS and send back any unused vaccine

FluMist

- No longer available for ordering through CVP this season
- For doses that will expire on or before February 1, 2026 use AstraZeneca's [FluMist® Replacement Program](#)
- Requests must be made by January 30, 2026
- Expired/expiring doses must be received by McKesson by February 14, 2026

RSV Ordering



RSV Mid-Season Update

- RSV administration ends March 31st
- Review on-hand inventory and make a plan to immunize patients
- Goal to administer all doses by March 31st

Doses in circulation:

Nirsevimab Product	Number of Doses in the Field*
50 mg	4,835
100 mg	4,131

*8,009 (\$3.3M) of these doses will expire before the start of next season

- Doses cannot be returned at the end of the season--they must be used

Ordering Controls in Effect

- Ordering controls are back in place
- Doses that will not be used by March 31st should be [advertised in the IIS](#)
- Providers should [check advertisements](#) before placing orders

- CVP will conduct outreach to providers with inventory and offer support with dose transfers
- Providers may be asked to accept a transfer before new orders are approved

Clesrovimab (ENFLONSIA) Ordering

Clesrovimab (ENFLONSIA) ordering opened January 2, 2026

- You must choose an RSV product for infants under 8 months of age-- Either clesrovimab (ENFLONSIA) or nirsevimab (Beyfortus)
 - You are not required to order Clesrovimab for patients under 8 months of age—they may continue to order nirsevimab for this age group
- Orders for clesrovimab will not be approved until facility is at a 2-week supply of nirsevimab
- Providers may be asked to accept a transfer of nirsevimab rather than switching to clesrovimab to utilize existing doses
- All providers must have a clear plan to use all nirsevimab or clesrovimab doses by the end of RSV season (March 31)

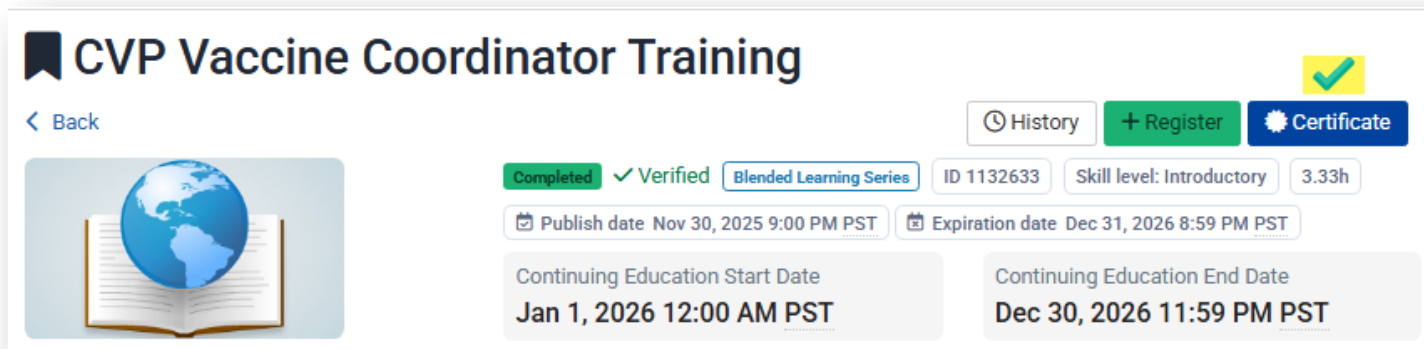
