




Documenting Immunity to Measles

How do I document a patient’s immunity to measles directly in the WAIS?

1. Log into the WAIS.
2. [Search](#) for your patient. [Add](#) a new patient if no record is found.
3. Open the blue **Vaccinations** menu tab on the left and click **View/Add**.
 
4. Scroll to the bottom of the **Vaccinations View/Add** page. Click the **Special Considerations** box.
 
5. If indicated, select your clinic from the **Facility Where Documented** drop-down.
6. Select the radio button to the left of **Contraindication**.
7. Choose **MMR** from the **Vaccine** drop-down if immunity is confirmed for measles, mumps and rubella. Choose **measles** if immunity is confirmed for measles only.
8. Select the **Contraindication** reason from the drop-down.
 - a. DO NOT USE the reason ‘Patient or parent report of disease’.
 - b. Select **Laboratory evidence of immunity** or **Serology confirmed measles**.
9. IMPORTANT: Checking the **Permanent** box will cause MMR to be contraindicated for the patient in the IIS forecast. MMR will be forecasted if the Permanent box is unchecked.
10. Click **Save**.
11. Navigate back to the **Vaccinations View/Add** page and scroll to the bottom to see the **Contraindication**.
 

Can I use the Serology Module to document immunity to measles?

The IIS Serology Module can be used to document immunity in the WAIS. Special user permissions are required for the use of this module, and only [‘owning’](#) organizations and facilities can use it for their *active* patients. When a measles titer is recorded in the Serology Module, MMR is automatically contraindicated in the patient’s forecast. To ensure that MMR is not removed from the patient’s forecast or show as contraindicated, document measles immunity as a non-permanent special consideration as instructed above.

Can I send measles immunity data to the WAIS from my EHR?

Some EHRs can send special considerations and serology data but they will be marked as permanent in the WAIS. To ensure that MMR is not removed from the patient’s forecast, document measles immunity directly in the WAIS as a non-permanent special consideration as instructed above.
