Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners, and Professionals:

In accordance with chapter [43.376 RCW](#), the [Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989](#), and [DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure](#), we are providing information on how you can access the Washington State Department of Health (WA-DOH) [Restricted Access Opioid and Drug Use Data Dashboard](#).

**Opportunity:** Access to the restricted version of this dashboard is for staff from local and Tribal Partners, and state opioid and overdose response plan partners. The restricted version of the dashboard provides enhanced data visibility for public health planning and response by removing [small-number suppression](#).

To request access, please complete this [Dashboard Access Request Form](#). If you do not have an Opioid Data Sharing Agreement (DSA), one will be executed through the DOH Contracts Office for this process. If you already have a DSA on file, you'll complete a RHINO Confidentiality Agreement form. **Background:** The Opioid and Drug Use Data Dashboard was designed to support informed, timely public health action across Washington State. It consolidates and visualizes a wide range of opioid and overdose-related data in near real time, with a focus on detecting potential misuse trends, monitoring response and support efforts, and connecting users to verified statewide resources.
