## Fiscal Year in Review 2024

### At A Glance

Fund Balance: \$223,000

- Decreased \$21,000
  Revenue: \$429,000
- Applications: 550 (-10%)
- Renewals: 2,658 (-4%)

Expenditures: \$451,000


### Significant Highlights

- Revenue was lower in FY2024 due to the uneven distribution of licenses over the 2 year fee cycle.
- Overall, costs decreased due to a decline in HELMS obligations and the use of one-time funding to support credentialing backlogs, and the completion of SSB5753 and SB5518 legislation.
- Disciplinary costs increased due to higher than anticipated investigative, legal, and attorney general activity.


