# Reproductive Health Services, 13136

# Policy/Procedure

#### **PURPOSE:**

In accordance with WAC 246-320-141 and RCW 70.41.520, this document describes the reproductive health care services generally available at Seattle Children's Hospital.

### **POLICY:**

Seattle Children's provides specific specialized reproductive health care services through the <u>Seattle Children's Prenatal Diagnosis and Treatment Program</u>; the <u>Adolescent Medicine Program</u> including its <u>Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology practice</u>; and, as appropriate and medically necessary, in the emergency department and acute care inpatient and outpatient hospital settings. These services are listed in the <u>Hospital Reproductive Services form provided to the Washington State Department of Health</u>.

In cases where medically necessary services are not available at Seattle Children's, patients are provided with information about, and/or referrals to, facilities that may provide those services.
