### **Prevention Update**



#### **Provider Materials**

- DOH is finalizing a Folic Acid fact sheet for Community Health Workers and health care providers.
- DOH has a reference sheet with links to free health education materials available for download.
- DOH, Local Health, Memorial Hospital and the March of Dimes are collaborating to disseminate educational materials to Community Health Workers and providers in Central Washington.



#### **Public Messaging**

- DOH has undertaken a media campaign in Central Washington to raise awareness about the importance of folic acid for women of childbearing age.
- 30-second messages developed by March of Dimes
- Radio messages in English and Spanish
- Focused in Benton, Franklin and Yakima counties
- We expect to reach 88-92% of targeted women, with women hearing the messages on average 14 times.



#### **Public Messaging**

- DOH has undertaken a separate media campaign in Central Washington with preconception health messaging.
- 12 episode radio novela developed by Oregon DOH
- Segments in Spanish
- Focused in Benton, Franklin and Yakima counties
- Transcripts available in <u>English</u> and <u>Spanish</u> on DOH website



#### Other Prevention Efforts

- Continue communication with Vitamin Angels to secure subsidized vitamins.
- Continuing to monitor the March of Dimes efforts to have corn masa flour supplemented with folic acid.

## Preconception Vitamin Use, PRAMS, Washington 2010-2012

- 58% (51%, 64%) of women residents of Benton,
   Franklin, Yakima counties reported never taking a vitamin with folic acid in the month before pregnancy
- 46% (44%, 49%) rest of Washington
- 26% (21%, 33%) Benton, Franklin, Yakima daily use
- 36% (34%, 39%) rest of Washington
- Data are too sparse to look at single years of data



### Anencephaly and Neural Tube Defect Rates, 1987-1988

- Benton, Franklin, Yakima: 9 infants with NTD
- 11,271 births
- Rate: 8.0 (3.7, 15.2) per 10,000 live births
- No cases of anencephaly




## Impact on Rates of Including Cases where pregnancy ended before 20 weeks gestation

- 61 NTD including 19 < 20 weeks gestation</li>
- 41 Anencephaly including 18 < 20 wks gestation</li>
- 2011-2014 Anencephaly rate if exclude cases < 20 wks</li>
   5.4 (3.2, 8.5)
- Rate if exclude cases < 17 wks</li>
   6.8 (4.4, 10.3)
- Rate if exclude cases < 15 wks</li>
   7.8 (5.1, 11.4)
