Updated: February 4, 2020

Senate Bill 5380 mandated facilities, entities, offices or provider groups with ten or more prescribers (with the exception of critical access hospitals) to fully integrate their electronic health records (EHR) with the Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) by January 1, 2021. Some EHR systems are not currently capable of connecting with Washington's Health Information Exchange (HIE) in order to integrate with the PMP.

To assist with integration, the following vendors can be used to connect an EHR to the HIE only, for the purposes of exchanging PMP data:
