

COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout in Washington State

Conceptually, vaccine rollout can be thought of as a three-legged stool: supply, logistics, and demand. All three legs are necessary to be effective in balancing goals of getting as many Washingtonians vaccinated quickly and equitably.



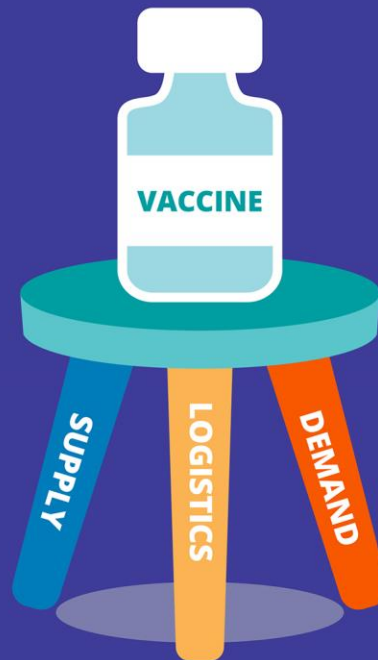
SUPPLY

Number of vaccine doses coming into state of Washington and then to local communities



LOGISTICS

Ability to administer vaccine doses when available in a timely and effective manner



DEMAND

Willingness of Washingtonians to seek and/or receive vaccine when eligible and available

Any imbalance in the “legs” of the stool during different phases of vaccine rollout will lead to challenges in the ultimate goal of achieving adequate vaccine coverage across Washington.
