- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.43 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Health plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2020, 8 shall provide benefits or coverage for contralateral prophylactic
- 9 mastectomies to covered individuals who:
- 10 (a) Are determined by their physician to be at a high risk of 11 developing breast cancer in the contralateral breast;
- 12 (b) Have a genetic defect that predisposes them to breast cancer; 13 or
- 14 (c) Have a desire for symmetry and reconstruction of both breasts 15 following removal of a breast due to breast cancer.
- 16 (2)(a) A health carrier is not required under this section to 17 provide for a referral to a nonparticipating health care provider, 18 unless the carrier does not have an appropriate health care provider 19 that is available and accessible to administer the procedure and that
- 20 a participating health care provider with respect such

21 procedure.

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(b) If a health carrier refers an individual to a nonparticipating health care provider pursuant to this section, screening services or a resulting procedure, if any, must be provided at no additional cost to the individual beyond what the individual would otherwise pay for services provided by a participating health care provider.

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
