#1. Onioid	Prescribing	Task Force:
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Purpose: Acting as representatives from each Board or Commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.

<u>**Outcome:**</u> A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all Boards and Commissions support.

#2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:

<u>Purpose</u>: Collect input from the public and stakeholders to shape how **DOH will:**

- Establish an overdose notification message for providers;
- Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities/ groups;
- Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
