Overall Goal of these meetings (from HB 1427)

Reduce the Opioid Epidemic in Washington State through the following two projects.

<p>#1: Opioid Prescribing Task Force:</p> <p><i>Purpose:</i> Acting as representatives from each Board or Commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.</p> <p><i>Outcome:</i> A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all Boards and Commissions support.</p>	<p>#2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:</p> <p><i>Purpose:</i> Collect input from the public and stakeholders to shape how DOH will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish an overdose notification message for providers; • Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities/groups; • Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
