### Overall Goal of these meetings (from HB 1427)

Reduce the Opioid Epidemic in Washington State through the following two projects.

#1: 0	oioid	<b>Prescribing</b>	Task Force:

<u>**Purpose:**</u> Acting as representatives from each Board or Commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.

<u>**Outcome:**</u> A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all Boards and Commissions support.

# **#2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:**

<u>Purpose</u>: Collect input from the public and stakeholders to shape how **DOH will:** 

- Establish an overdose notification message for providers;
- Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities/ groups;
- Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
