Thank you for your October 24, 2017, e-mail requesting to withdraw the Nursing Home Alternative Use Bed Banking Notice submitted for Sea Mar Community Care Center on September 22, 2017. As of the date of this letter, your bed banking request is withdrawn with no action on the project.

As outlined in Washington Administrative Code 246-310-990(7), review fees for exemption requests are nonrefundable.

Based on our telephone conversation, I understand that Sea Mar Community Nursing Facility (licensee) intends to relinquish 52 beds at Sea Mar Community Care Center with no alternate use bed banking. The number of beds to remain licensed at Sea Mar Community Care Center is 48. Please note that once the beds have been relinquished, any increase in nursing home beds requires prior Certificate of Need review and approval.
