Overall Goal of these meetings (from HB 1427)

Reduce the Opioid Epidemic in Washington State through the following two projects.

Purpose: Acting as representatives from each Board or Commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.

Outcome: A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all Boards and Commissions support.

#2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:

- Establish an overdose notification message for providers:
- Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities/ groups;
- Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
