In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Virginia Mason Medical Center (Virginia Mason) hereby submits a letter of intent proposing to establish a Level II neonatal service at our hospital located in the Central King Hospital Planning Area.

In conformance with the WAC, the following information is provided:

1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:

Virginia Mason is proposing to establish a 5 bed Level II neonatal service. Existing licensed beds will be used to establish the service.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:

The total estimated capital expenditure is \$3,282,500.

3. Description of the Service Area:

The primary service area parallels our network of neighborhood primary care clinics and includes King County and portions of Southern Snohomish County.
