Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 18.74.023 and RCW 18.74.500		
Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The law requires at least ten		
states to pass legislation to establish a physical therapist (PT) licensure compact. Washington was the 10th state to enact the		
PTLC. The compact's provisions are now in effect, and creates an interstate commission, to which Washington will send a		
delegate to provide oversight to the compact. Rules are being considered by the board to comply with HB 1278, which		
requires the board to review the rules adopted by the commission. The compact commission rules are not effective in		
Washington unless the board adopts them. The PTLC will allow well-qualified physical therapists and physical therapist		
assistants to obtain expedited practice privileges across any or all compact member states. The goal of the PTLC is to promote license portability and facilitate telehealth, which will provide greater access to physical therapy services, especially		
in rural and underserved areas in Washington.
