Seattle Cancer Care Alliance (SCCA) hereby submits this letter of intent to add eight (8) beds to its licensed bed capacity. The following information is to comply with the requirements of WAC 246-310-080(1):

- A. <u>Description of the Services Proposed.</u> SCCA operates a 20 bed "hospital within a hospital" at the University of Washington Medical Center. SCCA is licensed under RCW 70.41. The eight bed expansion will assure that SCCA is able to maintain its patient care services and continue to operate in full compliance with applicable conditions of participation. At project completion, SCCA will be licensed for 28 beds.
- B. <u>Estimated Cost of the Proposed Acquisition</u>. The capital expenditure is estimated to be \$50,000.
- C. <u>Description of Service Area.</u> SCCA is located in the North King Hospital Planning Area. Less than 6% of our patients reside in North King, another 72% reside in one of Washington's 39 Washington Counties, making the entirety of State the Service Area for purposes of this letter of Intent.
