RE: Determination of Reviewability #21-01

Dear Ms. Forsman:

The Department of Health has completed its review of the determination of reviewability request submitted by Olympia Orthopaedic Associates, PLLC (Olympia Orthopaedic). The request proposes an exemption from Certificate of Need review for a new ambulatory surgical facility (ASF) in Lacey, within Thurston County.

The determination of reviewability request and the department's research shows that:

- Olympia Orthopaedic is a Washington professional limited liability company. And both its clinical practice and surgical facility are under single ownership and united business identifier [UBI] 601 617 151.
- The professional limited liability company currently is governed by:

- The proposed ASF and clinical practice will be located at 7770 Britton Parkway NE, Lacey, Washington [98516]
- Olympia Orthopaedic has an active license from the Washington State Department of Health for an existing ASF¹ located in Olympia, within Thurston County. This new proposed facility would operate independently under its own ASF license.
- Olympia Orthopaedic is a group practice and use of the proposed ASF would be limited to physicians in the group practice.

- The anticipated revenue derived from surgical services provided at Olympia Orthopaedic will be approximately 43.69% of the total revenue generated by the new facility.
- The anticipated patient visits for surgical services provided by Olympia Orthopaedic will be approximately 4.63% of the total patient visits at the new facility.
- Clinical and surgical services to be provided at Olympia Orthopaedic will include: orthopedic, pain management, and eligible spine and neurosurgery procedures.
- When the project is complete and services are available, Olympia Orthopaedic will have six operating rooms².

CONCLUSION

Based on the totality of information presented in the request for determination of reviewability, screening response, and resulting research, the department concludes that Olympia Orthopaedic Associates, PLLC does not require a certificate of need at this time. Under this determination Olympia Orthopaedic Associates, PLLC is authorized to establish a facility providing orthopedic, pain management, and eligible spine and neurosurgery procedures in six operating rooms.

CHANGES THAT MAY EFFECT THIS DECISION

If changes are made in the ownership, operation, services, number of operating rooms, location, or if use of the ASF is extended to physicians that are not part of the Olympia Orthopaedic practice, the ASF may no longer qualify for this determination. In that event, certificate of need review and approval or new determination of reviewability request would be required.

APPEAL OPTION

This decision may be appealed. You or any person with standing may request an adjudicative proceeding to contest this decision within 28 calendar days from the date of this letter. The notice of appeal must be filed according to the provisions of Revised Code of Washington 34.05 and Washington Administrative Code 246-310-610. A request for an adjudicative proceeding must be received within the 28 days at one of the addresses listed on the following page.


