The Department of Health (department) is recruiting to fill three positions on the Washington State Mental Health Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Social Workers Advisory Committee. The committee provides advice to the secretary of health (secretary) on issues related to licensees' practice. The secretary appoints all members.

Current vacancies on the committee:

- One marriage and family therapist
- Two public members

Applicant eligibility:

- Must be residents of Washington state.
- May not hold an office in a professional association for their profession.
- May not be employed by Washington state.
- Applicants interested in the marriage and family therapist position must be actively engaged in their profession for at least five years immediately preceding appointment.
- Public members must represent the general public and be unaffiliated directly or indirectly with the professions.

Meetings

The committee meets four times a year at the Department of Health offices in Tumwater. However, during the pandemic, all meetings have been conducted online and will continue until the governor has lifted the emergency proclamation. When in-person meetings resume, committee members will be reimbursed for travel expenses. In addition, members are compensated \$50 per day for attending a meeting.
