Activities in the Growing Area in 2023

The growing area is classified for the subtidal harvest of scallops. Product harvested from the growing area was relayed to a grow-out site in Shoal Bay. The approved relay timeframe is November 1st through April 30th.

Analytical Results of Water Samples

A marine station (101) is in the growing area solely for the purposes of approving relay harvest activities. The station is not shown on the growing area map. No bacterial water samples are required from this station.

Change in Actual Pollution Sources that Impact the Growing Area

We currently have no information indicating that the area has new sources of pollution.




