PART I

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Introduction

This report contains a summary presentation in tabular form of the vital events which occurred during the year of 1978.

In the interest of easy comparison, the same format of tabular presentation has been continued herein as was initiated in the 1977 summary.

Population data are the official 1978 estimates for the State of Washington.

Unlike earlier years we are reporting summary statistics in two parts. Part 1 contains tables in a format similar to previous years reports. Part 2 will provide additional analysis and summary statistics relevant to planners.



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
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FERTILITY RATE AND BIRTH RATE PER 1,000 LIVEBIRTHS:

1978 VITAL STATISTICS NARRATIVE FOR SUMMARY

GENERAL POPULATION:

The State of Washington had a net gain of 112,319 persons in the official population estimate for April 1, 1978. This compares with a 90,375 increase for 1977 amounting to a 3.1% increase for 1978 and a 2.5% increase for 1977.

The population 65 and over is estimated to be 402,185 which is an increase of 15,471 over 1977. This amounts to a 4.0% increase for 1978. Since 1970 the state population has grown by 10.7% while the population 65 and over has grown by 20.1%.

Persons of Spanish surname (as defined by the 1970 Census) constitute the largest minority group in Washington. They are followed by Blacks, Indians and Asians in that order. The percent increase for the different minority groups varies greatly. Since 1970 the White population (excluding Spanish surname) increased by 8.9%. Spanish surname population increased by 30.2% (possibly as a result of an undercount in 1970). The Black population has grown by 19.2%, the Indian population by 52.7%, and the Asian population by 50.8%.


These population data, provided by the Office of Financial Management, suggest that Washington State is becoming older and more diverse in ethnic minorities.

NATALITY

There were 1,469 more livebirths in Washington in 1978 than there were in 1977. This is smaller than the 4,252 increase reported in 1977; the birthrate declining from 15.6 per 1,000 estimated population in 1977 to 15.5 in 1978.


BIRTH and DEATH RATES 1915 - 1978

MORTALITY

There were 680 more deaths (30,469) recorded in 1978 than in 1977. The death rate decreased from 9.2 per 1,000 population in 1958 to 8.1 per 1,000 population in 1978.

INFANT MORTALITY

There was an increase of 41 infant deaths in 1978 (737) from the previous year, which resulted in a rate of 12.6 per 1,000 livebirths. This is an increase of 0.4 over the 1977 rate (12.2).


The Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) was first listed as a separate cause of death in the International Classification of Disease, Adapted (ICDA), 8th Revision, in 1974. There were 15 more SIDS deaths (149) recorded in 1978 than in 1977.

FETAL DEATHS

There were 39 more fetal deaths (465) in Washington in 1978, with a ratio of 7.9 fetal deaths to 1,000 livebirths.

MATERNAL DEATHS

There were four maternal deaths in 1978, a decrease by one from 1977, resulting in a rate of 0.7 per 10,000 livebirths. Two deaths were to White mothers and two were Black mothers. The age distribution shows one death each in the 20-24 and 25-29 age groups, and two in the 35-39 age group.

MARRIAGE AND DISSOLUTION

There were 45,109 marriages performed in 1978, 1,372 more than reported in 1977. The total terminations of marriage were 26,416. This is a decrease of 67 from that reported in 1977. Of these terminations, 172 were annulments and 44 were separate maintenance decrees. In seven cases the type of decree was not stated.

BACKGROUND

RELIABILITY OF THE DATA

In analyzing any data, the possibility of errors in the data must not be overlooked. There are several types of possible errors, including under-registration, errors made by the informant, and errors in compilation and processing. The most potentially dangerous error, however, is probably that of improper interpretation.

Statistics are neither more true nor false than the interpretation given to them. It should be emphasized that most of the rates computed in this report are crude rates. For comparing geographic areas, crude rates are limited. They do not reflect differences in age, sex, race, and other population characteristics. In addition, it is important to recognize the possible distortion in these rates where the number of events or the population is small. Minor variations in the number of events may result in major changes in the rates. Special caution should also be exercised in analysing trend data, because of changes throughout the years in medical diagnosis, coding definitions, and registration coverage.

POPULATION

Population data in this report is an estimate of population, April 1, 1978, provided by the Office of Program Planning and Fiscal Management, House Office Building, Olympia, Washington.

RATES

Rates are calculated by dividing the event of concern by the population at risk or a related population and multiplying by a constant. Death rates from all causes and livebirths are expressed in terms of 1,000 estimated population; deaths from a specific cause are based on 100,000 estimated population (excluding maternal and infant causes); maternal deaths are calculated per 10,000 livebirths; infant, neonatal and fetal deaths are calculated per 1,000 livebirths.

CAUSE OF DEATH CLASSIFICATION

The cause of death presented herein are classified in accordance with the Eighth Revision of the International Classification of Diseases, Adapted, 1967; Public Health Service Publication No. 1693, U.S. Government Printing Office.

Specific causes of death in this report are shown in groupings of 79 causes. Leading causes were selected from a consolidation of these 79 causes.

RATES AND WHOLE NUMBERS

Rates are rounded to the nearest tenth. When the rate or percent is less than one-tenth, the entry is left blank.

When whole numbers are used, a blank or dash (-) indicates none or zero.

DEFINITIONS

GENERAL TERMS

BIRTH WEIGHT - Weight of fetus or infant at time of delivery (normally recorded in pounds and ounces).

FETAL DEATH - A birth after 20 weeks gestation which is not a live birth.

GESTATIONAL PERIOD - Number of weeks elapsed between the first day of the last menstrual period and date of delivery.

INFANT DEATH - Death of an infant under one year of age.

LIVE BIRTH - A birth that shows any sign of life after delivery.

LIVE BIRTH ORDER - Order number is equal to number of previous livebirths plus current birth.

MATERNAL DEATH - Death attributable to complications of pregnancy, childbirth, or the puerperium.

NEONATAL DEATH - Death of an infant within the first 27 days of life.

OCCURRENCE DATA - Data allocated by place where event occurred, regardless of the person's place of residence.

PERINATAL DEATH - Includes stillbirths and deaths to infants within the first six days of life.

PREMATURE BIRTH - A livebirth weighing 5 1/2 pounds (2,500 grams) or less. If birth weight is not stated, length of gestation (under 37 weeks) is used.

RESIDENCE DATA - Data allocated by place of residence of the decedent (deaths), or by place of residence of the child's mother (births, stillbirths).

RATES

AGE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATE - Number of deaths in a specific age group per 100,000 population in that age group.

CAUSE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATE - Number of deaths from a specific cause per 100,000 population.

(CRUDE) BIRTH RATE - Number of live births per 1,000 population.

(CRUDE) DEATH RATE - Number of deaths per 1,000 population.

FERTILITY RATE - Number of livebirths per 1,000 women 15-44 years of age.

FETAL DEATH RATE - Number of stillbirths per 1,000 livebirths.

INFANT DEATH RATE - Number of infant deaths per 1,000 livebirths.

MATERNAL DEATH RATE - Number of maternal deaths per 10,000 livebirths.

NEONATAL DEATH RATE - Number of neonatal deaths per 1,000 livebirths.

PERINATAL DEATH RATE - Number of perinatal deaths per 1,000 livebirths,
plus fetal deaths.


