Washington State Department of Health – Family Planning Program Emergency Contraception for Victims of Sexual Assault

Every hospital providing emergency care to a victim of sexual assault must give you information about emergency contraception. If not medically contraindicated, the hospital must provide emergency contraception immediately at the hospital to each victim of sexual assault whorequests it. (RCW 70.41.350)

Emergency contraception can help prevent pregnancy after sexual assault

• It is important to start emergency contraception promptly

Safe and effective emergency contraception options include:

- More than 99%* pregnancy risk reduction Paragard Copper T, intrauterine device
- 94%* pregnancy risk reduction ella or ellaOne, progesterone modulator pills
- 89% * pregnancy risk reduction Plan B One-Step, or generics, progestin-only pills
- 75% * pregnancy risk reduction Estrogen/progestin pills or high doses of oral contraceptive pills *Note:*

Other options may be available. Talk with your medical provider about the best choice for you. Options can be made undetectable by partner, talk with your medical provider *Pregnancy risk reduction based on one-time use.

Emergency contraception is NOT

- The same as the abortion pill, RU-486
- Capable of interrupting an established pregnancy
- Capable of harming a developing fetus
- Capable of affecting a woman's ability to become pregnant in the future
- Protection against sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV/AIDS

In the case of sexual assault, where can you get emergency contraception?

- Hospital emergency rooms in Washington State
- Some pharmacies in Washington State
- Healthcare providers and clinics
