out of 3 adults have prediabetes

Individual medical costs of having diabetes reaches

COST OF DIABETES





This is **twice** as high as for people without diabetes

People who have diabetes are at higher risk of serious health complications:











Without weight loss and moderate

adults are aware

they have prediabetes



15-30% of people with prediabetes will develop type 2 diabetes within 5 years



Risk of death for adults with diabetes

TYPES OF DIABETES



BODY DOES NOT MAKE ENOUGH INSULIN

- Can develop at any age
- No known way to prevent it

More than 18,000 new cases among people younger than 20 years in US each year

BODY CANNOT USE INSULIN PROPERLY

- Can develop at any age
- Most cases can be prevented
