### Overall Goal of these meetings (from HB 1427)

Reduce the opioid epidemic in Washington State through the following two projects.

### No. 1: Opioid Prescribing Task Force:

**<u>Purpose:</u>** Acting as representatives from each board or commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.

<u>Outcome:</u> A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all boards and commissions form consensus on and agree to adopt.

#### No. 2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:

<u>Purpose</u>: Collect input from the public and stakeholders to shape how **DOH will:** 

- Establish an overdose notification message for providers;
- Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities and groups;
- Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
