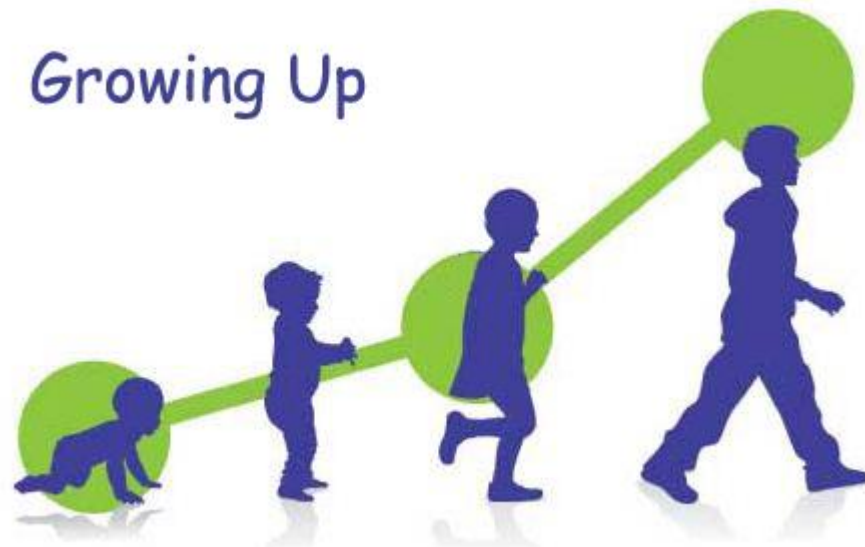

Hepatitis B Vaccine Shortage Update

- ❑ Continue through the end of the year
- ❑ Childhood Vaccine Program will be using both products
- ❑ **The two vaccines are interchangeable.**

- ❑ The recommendations for HepB vaccination of infants has not changed

Influenza 2017-2018 Summary

- 690,000 doses ordered
- 93,650 doses remaining unordered
- Flu doses received at depot 7/26/17-10/12/17
- Flu orders approved starting 8/29/17



Influenza 2018-2019

- 4 Presentations
 - FluLaval syringe
 - Fluzone multi-dose vial
 - Fluzone .25 syringe
 - FluMist
- 670,000 doses – 690,000 doses



FluMist Input Needed

For the upcoming CDC Pre-book:

1. Order 20,000 additional doses of FluMist
2. Order 0 dose of FluMist, stick with the 20,000 doses we have ordered
3. Order **X** number of doses of FluMist

LAIV things to consider

- ✓ **100% return if pre-book before *May 31, 2018***
- ✓ **10-12 week expiration**
- ✓ **No confirmed delivery date**
- ✓ **Available on CDC Fall Pre-book**
- ✓ **ACIP recommendations**
- ✓ **AAP recommendations**

Recommendations of the ACIP

For the 2018–19 U.S. influenza season, providers may choose to administer any licensed, age-appropriate influenza vaccine (IIV, recombinant influenza vaccine [RIV], or LAIV4). LAIV4 is an option for those for whom it is otherwise appropriate. No preference is expressed for any influenza vaccine product.

AAP Recommendations

- ❑ American Academy of Pediatrics Advises Parents to Choose the Flu Shot For 2018-2019 Flu Season.
- ❑ *AAP finds the inactivated influenza vaccine to be more consistently effective against most strains of flu, but says the nasal vaccine may be a last resort for kids who otherwise will not be vaccinated.*

LAIV (FluMist) Update
