## **INTRODUCTION:**

This emergency meeting was called to address concerns from the industry that the August 2020 Table 2 does not require enough square feet for the drainfield.

#### TAG unanimous decisions:

- The original Table 2 (2007) will be the starting point for the revision of Table 2. It was advised by Dave Lowe that this table is correct for soil types 1-4. Dave Lowe will work on new values for soil types 5 and 6.
- Table 2: the note referring to "commercial applications" after the footnotes will be removed.
- Table 5 will become Table 3 and "non-residential applications" will be removed.

# On-Site Wastewater Technical Advisory Group

- Add to the as-built/record drawing requirement that it should include the make of the dripline, emitter discharge of the dripline in gallons per hour/emitter and maximum daily discharge gallons per day/per emitter.
- The dosing frequency will be as in the August 2020 Table 2. Soil type 5 = 8 doses and Soil type 6 = 4 doses.

Dave Lowe will work on a revision of Table 2 and a second emergency meeting will be called to review, discuss and vote on the revision.
