Talking and Sharing Your Webcam

We suggest logging in at least 5 minutes early to get your audio and webcams set up before the meeting.

All attendees entering the webinar will be automatically muted. Staff will unmute VAC members. You can select your audio options by viewing the “Audio” tab of the GoToWebinar panel. You can use your computer audio or you can call in using a phone. Please note that those using computer audio without a headset may cause audio feedback when unmuted.

VAC members who wish to share their webcams will be assigned as ‘panelists’ for the webinar. If you do not wish to share your webcam during the call, please email Phillip.wiltzius@doh.wa.gov so we can reserve a webcam spot for someone else. We are limited at 25 cameras including presenters.

All other VAC members not sharing their webcams will have their lines unmuted for the webinar. We ask that you mute yourself when you are not talking.

Sharing Your Webcam Details

When you log in to the webinar and a staff member assigns you as a panelist, you will see additional options on your GoToWebinar panel. There will be a new bar called “Webcam.” Click on the “Share My Webcam” button to display your webcam. The icon will turn green to show that you are displaying your webcam.

To stop sharing your webcam, click on the “Share Your Webcam” button again and it will turn gray.
