- 2.1. Review of the Qualified Applied Behavior Analysis Credential (QABA) – The committee examined the administrative requirements for the QABA credentials and endorsed its adoption as an alternate route for the LBA credential. However, there were questions about whether the educational requirements meet the proposed requirements for licensure.
- 2.2. CBT Training Program Language – Ms. Pitzler asked the committee to review the current rules pertaining to the program and suggest revisions. Committee members and the public gave input regarding this issue.
- 2.3. CBT Continuing Education – Ms. Pitzler asked the committee to review the rule language for [WAC 246-805-410](#) and suggest revisions. Committee members and the public gave input regarding this issue.
- 2.4. Temporary License and Reciprocity – This topic was covered at the regular meeting on February 5, 2021. Ms. Pitzler asked committee members for further advice relating to potential language for both of these items. Committee members and the public gave input regarding these issues.
