The Department of Health (department) is recruiting to fill three positions on the Certified Counselors and Hypnotherapists Advisory Committee. The committee provides advice to the secretary of health (secretary) on issues related to the practice of certified counselors and hypnotherapists. The department is looking to appoint people who reflect the diversity of Washington's population and who provide geographic representation from throughout the state. The secretary of health appoints all members.

Current vacancies on the committee:

- One hypnotherapist
- Two members of the public who represent the public at large and who may not hold any mental health care provider license, certification, or registration

Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be residents of Washington state.
- May not hold a leadership position in a professional association for their profession.
- Professional members must have been actively engaged in their profession for five years preceding appointment.
- May not be employed by Washington state.
- Public members must represent the general public and be unaffiliated directly or indirectly with the professions credentialed under chapter 18.19 RCW.

The committee meets four times a year at the Department of Health offices in Tumwater. However, during the pandemic, all meetings have been conducted online and will continue until the governor has lifted the emergency proclamation. When in-person meetings resume, committee members will be reimbursed for travel expenses. In addition, members are compensated \$50 per day for attending a meeting.
