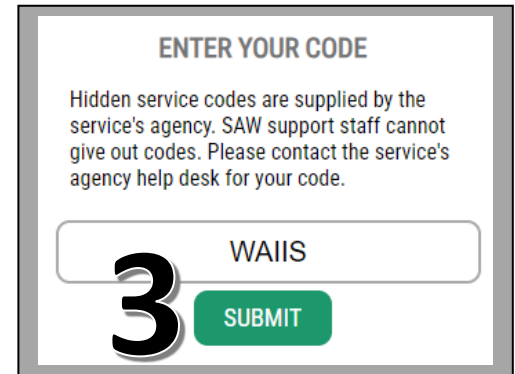
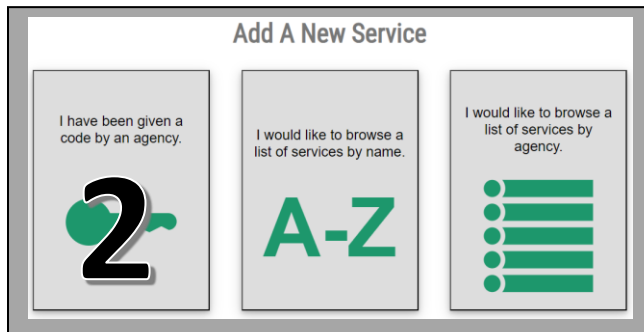
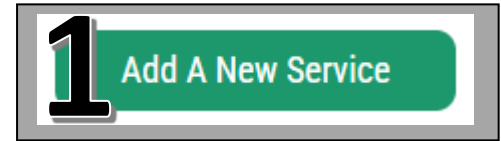




## How can I add the Washington State Immunization Information System (WAIS) to my SecureAccess Washington (SAW) Account?

1. Once logged into your [SAW](#) account, you will need to add WAIS as a service. Click 'Add a New Service'.
2. Select 'I have been given a code by an agency.'
3. Enter the code **WAIS** and click Submit.



4. You will be prompted to answer a series of questions based on your public record data to complete a Knowledge-Based Authentication (KBA). If you choose to bypass this Identity Verification, access to the WAIS service will be delayed until your identity can be manually verified.

### 4 IDENTITY VERIFICATION

You will be asked a series of questions based on your public record data (the state of Washington does not gather or store this data). These questions could be about things you have owned, people you know or your professional experience. [If you do not wish to answer these questions, you may request permission to skip this step.](#) This choice may delay access to your service. Requests to bypass this process will send a notification to the owner of the service who may reach out to you to verify your identity manually. Once verified, you will be able to continue the registration process for this service.

5. The WAIS should now be available as a service through your SAW account. Click 'Access Now'. You will be prompted to choose a method for completing a Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA). Enter the code sent to you and click 'Submit'. Click 'CONTINUE' to access the WAIS.
