At a Glance

Adolescents (ages 7-18) need 4 vaccines to protect against meningococcal disease, some cancers, tetanus, and other serious diseases, according to national guidelines.

AGE

IMMUNIZATIONS

9-10

- You may choose to offer **HPV dose 1**
- **HPV dose 2** (6 months after dose 1)

11-12

- **HPV dose 1** (if not given at ages 9-10)
- **HPV dose 2** (6 months after dose 1)
- **MCV4 dose 1**
- **Tdap** (one dose)

16

- **MCV4 dose 2**
- **MenB dose 1**
- **MenB dose 2** (1-2 months or 6 months after dose 1, depending on brand)

YEARLY

- **Flu Vaccine** (every year, every age, for adolescents)
