Arsenic Treatment

In May 2016, McKee's Evergreen Beach Association entered into a compliance agreement with DOH to address violation of water quality standards for arsenic for a community water system. Levels of manganese within the water supply also exceed recommended levels. This project allowed them to install a water treatment system for arsenic and manganese reduction, build a new reservoir, and replace two well pumps. They also upgraded the existing electrical instrumentation and controls to support the new treatment system. McKee's Evergreen Beach applied for and received a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund construction loan for:

- 💧 \$1,254,915.00, at 2.25 percent interest, with a twenty-year repayment period.

Construction began in spring 2021 and are expected to be in service by the summer of 2022.

Public health and environmental benefits

McKee's Evergreen Beach now provides safe and reliable drinking water that meets state standards. The additional storage makes it a more reliable system.
