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CASCADE SCREENING

Cascade Screening Connector (CSC) is a new public health service to address cancer conditions that run in families, such as Lynch Syndrome and Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer Syndrome.

CSC helps people with these cancer conditions: 1) identify family members who are at risk; and 2) connect them with doctors to prevent cancer.

Family members who are at risk commonly include first- and second-degree relatives such as parents, siblings, children, uncles, aunts, nieces, nephews, grandparents, grandchildren, and half-siblings.
