FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Using Reminder/Recall for Back to School

This document includes answers to questions asked during the Using Reminder/Recall for Back to School webinar.

Question 1: I currently work at a school, am I able to access the Coverage Rate Report? What is important for a school nurse to know about this webinar?

A school nurse generally needs to access the IIS to view immunization records to verify a patient's immunization status for school. In general, this type of user account is limited in access and does not have the permissions or tools in the IIS used for quality improvement, such as the Coverage Rate Report. This work typically occurs at the patient's primary medical home or clinic where they seek medical care.

Question 2: Do I need parental consent in order to print a Certificate of Immunization Status form or CIS?

It is not necessary to obtain permission before printing a Certificate of Immunization Status from the IIS.

Question 3: Is it a requirement to use the Reminder/Recall tool in the IIS? Can we use the tool in our Electronic Health Record instead?

There is no requirement for clinics to use the IIS for Reminder/Recall. This webinar shows users how to run coverage rate reports and use the reminder/recall tool that are available in the IIS, but you can use any tools you have available to support immunization quality improvement efforts.
