Immunization Information System

The Washington State Immunization Information System (WA IIS) is a secure, web-based, voluntary registry that consolidates lifetime immunization records for individuals of all ages. The system adheres to all federal and state security requirements to ensure the protection of personal health data.

Key Benefits of the WA IIS

Access to Records

- Centralized, electronic immunization records
- Pre-populated forms for school and child care entry

Clinical Decision Support

 Forecasts and displays due or overdue immunizations

School and Child Care Compliance

 Monitors immunization compliance for requirements

Quality Improvement Tools

 Tools to monitor data accuracy and send reminder/recall notices to patients

Electronic Data Exchange

- Integrates with Electronic Health Record (EHR) systems, allowing providers to:
 - Query the WA IIS to retrieve patient immunization records
 - Transmit immunization records to the WA IIS in near real time



Public Health Data

- Data available to measure immunization coverage at national, state, and local levels
- Supports outbreak response for vaccine-preventable diseases

MyIR and **WAVerify**

 Online portals provide individuals access to their own immunization records

Inventory Management

 Facilitates vaccine ordering, receiving, and reporting for clinics enrolled in the Childhood Vaccine Program

Program Support

 Supports <u>Childhood</u> and <u>Adult</u> Vaccine Programs, and <u>Watch Me Grow</u> <u>Washington</u>

Data Sharing Across Systems

 Participates in the Immunization Gateway (IZG) Project enabling data exchange with federal partners and other state registries

Immunization Data Snapshots

- Most Washington residents have at least one immunization record in the WA IIS, and most healthcare providers in the state actively use the system
- Over 170 million immunization records in the WA IIS
- 91% of records are submitted within 24 hours
- 90% of records submitted via electronic data exchange
- 3,313 electronic interfaces with provider EHR systems
- Over 58 million electronic HL7 messages processed in 2024
