



Medical Marijuana Consultant Certification

A certified consultant plays a vital role in the medical marijuana industry and is primarily there to assist qualifying patients. To become a certified consultant you must be at least 21 years old and have completed the following:

Step 1: Complete required training

- ⇒ Choose and complete a department-approved 20-hour training program
- ⇒ Complete a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training course that includes both a written examination and skills demonstration.

Step 2: Complete the application

- ⇒ Download the Medical Marijuana Certification Application Packet from our website
- ⇒ Review instructions on page 3
- ⇒ Complete, sign and date the application

Step 3: Submit application, required documentation and fees

Step 4: Renew before your birthday!

Certifications expire each year on the consultant’s birthday. Complete the following before your credential expires:

- ⇒ Complete 10-hours of continuing education
- ⇒ Renew CPR card
- ⇒ Renew online, by mail or in-person
