

# **Athletic Trainer License Application Packet**

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#### **Important Social Security Number Information:**

If you have a Social Security Number, the law requires you to disclose it on your application for a professional or occupational license. <u>42 U.S.C. § 666(a)(13)</u>; <u>RCW</u> <u>26.23.150</u>. It will be used under the state's child support enforcement program to locate individuals for purposes of establishing paternity and establishing, modifying, and enforcing support obligations. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. If you do not have a Social Security Number, you are still eligible to apply for and obtain a credential if you meet the requirements. Please see the <u>Declaration of No Social Security Number</u> <u>Form</u>. Please call the Customer Service Center at 360-236-4700 if you have questions.

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# **Application Instructions Checklist**

**Important background check Information:** Washington State law authorizes the Department of Health to obtain fingerprint-based background checks for licensing purposes. This check may be through the Washington State Patrol and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). This may be required if you have lived in another state or if you have a criminal record in Washington State. This would be at your own expense.

All information should be printed clearly in blue or black ink. It is your responsibility to submit the correct forms required.

Application Fee. This fee is non-refundable. You can check the online <u>fee page</u> for current fees.

#### Select if the following applies: Spouse or Registered Domestic Partner of Military Personnel

#### **1. Demographic Information:**

**Social Security Number:** You must list your social security number on your application. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. Please see the <u>Declaration of No Social Security Number Form</u>. Please call the Customer Service Center at 360-236-4700 if you do not have one.

**National Provider Identifier Number (NPI):** The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a standard unique identifier for health care professionals available from the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The NPI is a 10 digit numeric identifier. If you have a NPI number, provide this on your application.

Legal Name: List your full name: first, middle, and last.

**Definition of legal name:** "Legal name" is the name appearing on your official certificate of birth or, if your name has changed since birth, on an official marriage certificate or an order by a court. The court must have the legal authority to change your name. We may ask you to prove your legal name. If you use any name other than your legal name on this form, your application may be denied.

Birth date: Provide the month, day, and year of your birth.

**Address:** List the address we should use to send any information about your license. Be sure to include the city, state, zip code, county, and country. This will be your permanent address with Department of Health until we have been notified of a change. See <u>WAC 246-12-310</u>.

**Phone, Fax, and Cell Numbers:** Enter your phone, fax, and cell numbers, if you have them.

**Email:** Enter your email address, if you have one. Email is the Department's primary form of communication. Please ensure you are checking your spam folders for correspondence.

**Other Name(s):** Indicate whether you are known or have been known under any other names. If you have a name change, you must notify the Department of Health in writing. You must include proof of this change. See <u>WAC 246-12-300</u>.

#### **2. Personal Data Questions:**

All applicants must answer the same personal data questions. They are focused on your fitness to practice the essential skills of this profession.

If you answer "yes" to any questions in this section, you must provide an appropriate explanation. You must also provide the documentation listed in the note after the question. If you do not provide this, your application is incomplete and it will not be considered.

- Question 5 includes misdemeanors, gross misdemeanors and felonies. You do not have to answer yes if you have been cited for traffic infractions. You can get copies of court records through the county courthouse where the conviction, plea, deferred sentence, or suspended sentence was entered.
- If you have been granted certificate(s) of restoration of opportunity, please provide a certified copy of each certificate.
- Another jurisdiction means any other country, state, federal territory, or military authority.

#### 3. Training and Education:

List in date order, most recent to later, your educational preparation and postgraduate training. Attach additional pages if you need more space.

☐ If you received your education from an accredited educational program approved by the board of certification for the athletic trainer (BOC) submit official transcripts sent directly from your school to the Athletic Trainer Program. See <u>WAC 246-916-020</u>.

☐ If you received your education before January 1, 2004 the following is required per <u>WAC 246-916-020</u>:

- Completion of a Bachelors or advanced degree including course work in:
  - Health;
  - Human anatomy;
  - Kinesiology/biomechanics;
  - Human physiology;
  - Physiology of exercise and;
  - Basic and advanced athletic training.
- Completion of an internship with a minimum of 1,500 practical hours under the direct supervision of an athletic trainer certified by the BOC. Complete the affidavit in section three of the application to certify your internship.

#### 4. Examination:

The Board of Certification for Athletic Trainers (BOC) examination is the approved license exam. If you passed the national examination, you must request a written verification from BOC (Certification Verification) for Washington State. If you need to take the exam, contact BOC at <u>www.bocatc.org</u> or 877-262-3926 for examination registration instructions.

#### 5. Other License, Certification, or Registration:

List all states where credentials are or were held. Attach additional pages if you need more space.

Many states charge a verification/certification processing fee, please Note: contact them first to prevent a delay.



#### 6. Applicant's Attestation:

You must sign and date this for us to process the application.

We appreciate your interest in obtaining a license. You will be notified in writing if further documentation is required.

- The initial credential will expire on your birthday unless the credential is issued within 90 days of your next birthday. See WAC 246-12-020(3).
- You must keep your address up to date in order to receive a courtesy renewal notice. Any renewal post marked or presented to the department after midnight on the expiration date is late.

#### **Continuing Education Requirements:**

Athletic Trainers must complete a minimum of 50 hours of continuing education every two years. Your continuing education must be obtained during the period between renewals. See <u>WAC 246-916-060</u> for more information regarding continuing education.

#### For Spouses and Registered Domestic Partners of Military **Personnel Being Transferred or Stationed in Washington:**

Under state law, if you are the spouse or state-registered domestic partner of a servicemember of any branch of the U.S. Military, to include Guard or Reserve, and are applying for a health care professional credential in this state, you may be eligible to have the processing of your application expedited to receive your credential more quickly.

Documents to submit with your application should include the following:

- A copy of your spouse's or registered domestic partner's military transfer orders to Washington State.
- One of the following: •
  - A copy of your marriage certificate to show proof of marriage; or
  - A copy of a state's declaration or registration showing you are in a state registered domestic partnership with a member of the U.S. military.
