Important Social Security Number Information:

If you have a Social Security Number, the law requires you to disclose it on your application for a professional or occupational license. 42 U.S.C. § 666(a)(13); RCW 26.23.150. It will be used under the state's child support enforcement program to locate individuals for purposes of establishing paternity and establishing, modifying, and enforcing support obligations. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. If you do not have a Social Security Number, you are still eligible to apply for and obtain a credential if you meet the requirements. Please see the Declaration of No Social Security Number Form. 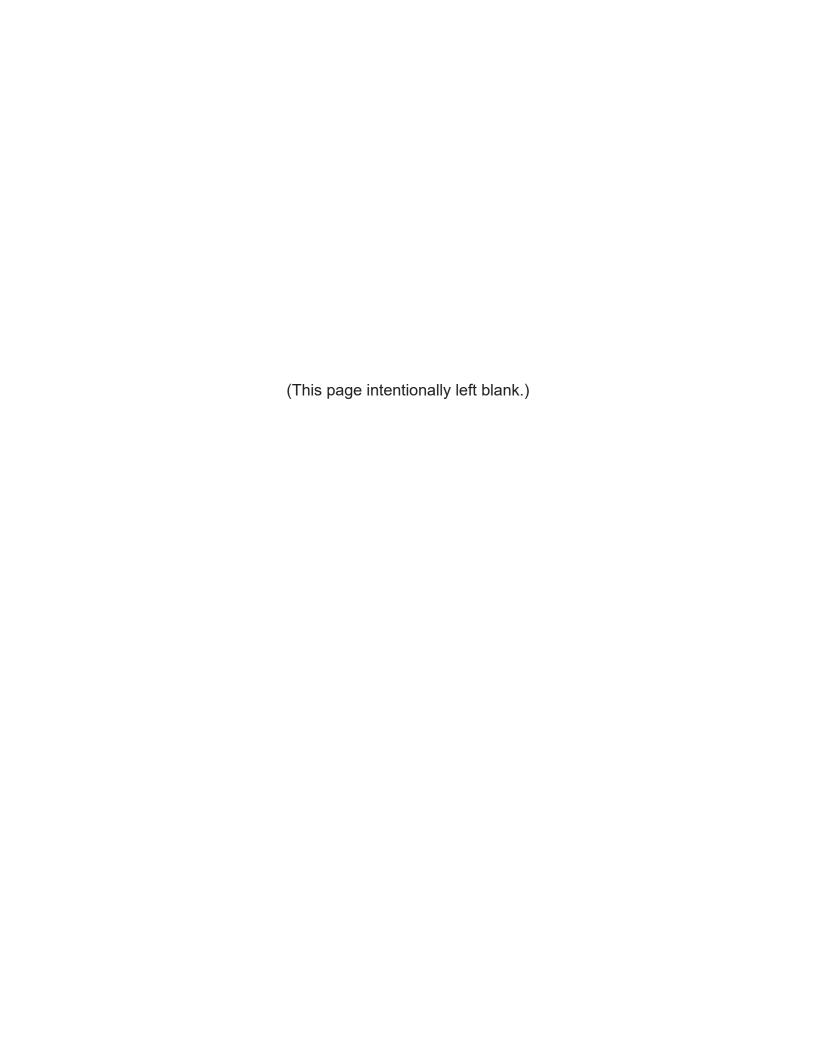

Application Instructions Checklist

You will be notified in writing if further documentation is required.

To ensure you have submitted the necessary fees and documentation, we encourage you to use the following checklist:

Pay Late Penalty Fee.

Pay Current Renewal Fee.

Pay Expired Credential Reissuance Fee.
All fees are non-refundable. You can check the online fee page for current fees.

1. Demographic Information.

Social Security Number: You must list your social security number on your application. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. Please see the Declaration of No Social Security Number Form. Please call the Customer Service Center at 360-236-4700 if you do not have one.

National Provider Identifier Number (NPI): The National Provider Identifier (NPI)

National Provider Identifier Number (NPI): The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a standard unique identifier for health care professionals available from the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The NPI is a 10 digit numeric identifier. If you have a NPI number, provide this on your application.

Legal Name: List your full name: first, middle, and last.

Definition of legal name: "Legal name" is the name appearing on your official certificate of birth or, if your name has changed since birth, on an official marriage certificate or an order by a court. The court must have the legal authority to change your name. We may ask you to prove your legal name. If you use any name other than your legal name on this form, your application may be denied.

Birth date: Provide the month, day, and year of your birth.

Address: List the address we should use to send any information about your credential. Be sure to include the city, state, zip code, county, and country. This will be your permanent address with Department of Health until we have been notified of a change. See **WAC 246-12-310**.

Phone, Fax, and Cell Numbers: Enter your phone, fax, and cell numbers, if you have them.

Email: Enter your email address, if you have one.

Other Name(s): Indicate whether you are known or have been known under any other names. If you have a name change, you must notify the Department of Health in writing. You must include proof of this change. See **WAC 246-12-300**.

2. Other License, Certification, or Registration. List all credentials you have held since last being credentialed in Washington State. List in date order, most current first. Include your last active credential in Washington State. Attach additional pages if you need more space.
3. Professional Experience. In date order, list all your professional work experience since your Washington State credential expired. Attach additional pages if you need more space.
4. Disciplinary Action Attestation. Required by WAC 246-12-040.
5. Continuing Education Attestation. Required by WAC 246-12-040.
6. Applicant's Attestation. Required to be both signed and dated in order to process the application.

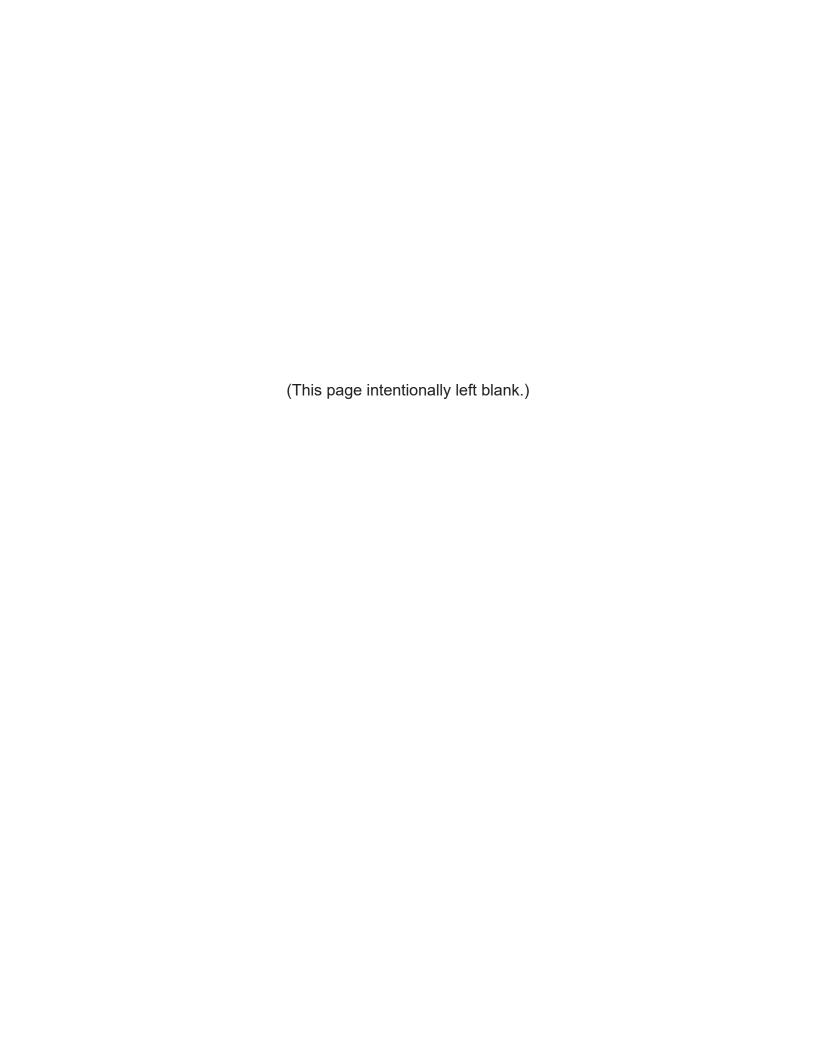
