

Marriage and Family Therapist Associate License Application Packet

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Important Social Security Number Information:

If you have a Social Security Number, the law requires you to disclose it on your application for a professional or occupational license. 42 U.S.C. § 666(a)(13); RCW 26.23.150. It will be used under the state's child support enforcement program to locate individuals for purposes of establishing paternity and establishing, modifying, and enforcing support obligations. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. If you do not have a Social Security Number, you are still eligible to apply for and obtain a credential if you meet the requirements. Please see the Declaration of No Social Security Number Form. 

Application Instructions Checklist

Important background check Information: Washington State law authorizes the Department of Health to obtain fingerprint-based background checks for licensing purposes. This check may be through the Washington State Patrol and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). This may be required if you have lived in another state or if you have a criminal record in Washington State. The cost of the background check is at the applicant's expense.

Select if the following applies:
 Application Fee. This fee is non-refundable. You can check the online fee page for current fees. This fee may be paid by a personal check or money order, payable to the Department of Health.

All information should be printed clearly in blue or black ink. It is your responsibility to

☐ 1. Demographic Information:

Social Security Number: You must list your social security number on your application. Please call the Customer Service Center at 360-236-4700 if you do not have one.

National Provider Identifier Number (NPI): The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a standard unique identifier for health care professionals available from the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The NPI is a 10 digit numeric identifier. If you have a NPI number, provide this on your application.

Legal Name: List your full name: first, middle, and last.

Spouse or Registered Domestic Partner of Military Personnel

Definition of legal name: "Legal name" is the name appearing on your official certificate of birth or, if your name has changed since birth, on an official marriage certificate or an order by a court. The court must have the legal authority to change your name. We may ask you to prove your legal name. If you use any name other than your legal name on this form, your application may be denied.

Birth date: Provide the month, day, and year of your birth.

Address: List the address we should use to send any information about your license. Be sure to include the city, state, zip code, county, and country. This will be your permanent address with the Department of Health until we have been notified of a change. See <u>WAC 246-12-310</u>.

Phone, Fax and Cell Numbers: Enter your phone, fax and cell numbers, if you have them.

Email: Enter your email address, if you have one.

Other Name(s): Indicate whether you are known or have been known under any other names. If you have a name change, you must notify the Department of Health in writing. You must include proof of this change. See **WAC 246-12-300**.

2. Personal Data Questions: All applicants must answer the same personal data questions. They are focused on your fitness to practice the essential skills of this profession.
If you answer "yes" to any questions in this section, you must provide an appropriate explanation. You must also provide the documentation listed in the note after the questions. If you do not provide this, your application is incomplete and it will not be considered.
 Question 5 includes misdemeanors, gross misdemeanors and felonies. You do not have to answer yes if you have been cited for traffic infractions. You can get copies of court records through the county courthouse where the conviction, plea, deferred sentence, or suspended sentence was entered.
 If you have been granted certificate(s) of restoration of opportunity, please provide a certified copy of each certificate.
 Another jurisdiction means any other country, state, federal territory, or military authority.
3. Education:
List your educational preparation. If you need more space, attach a piece of paper.
Approved educational programs include:
 Any college or university accredited by a national or regional accrediting body recognized by the Commission on Recognition of Postsecondary Accreditation or its successor; or
b. A program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education (COAMFTE).
Transcripts:
Your school must send official transcripts directly to the Department of Health.
4. Educational Qualifications: List equivalent course of graduate study or doctoral that includes courses in marital and family systems, marital and family therapy, individual development, psychopathology, human sexuality, research, professional ethics and law, supervised clinical practice and electives. A total of forty-five semester credits or sixty quarter credits are required. A minimum of twenty-seven semester credits or thirty-six quarter credits are required in the first six areas of study: Marital and Family Systems, Marital and Family Therapy, Individual Development, Psychopathology, Human Sexuality, and Research.
5. Other License, Certification, or Registration: List all states, including Washington, where credentials are or were held. Attach additional completed pages if you need more space. You must also print the Verification Form and provide it to each state or jurisdiction that you have listed, requesting that they complete and submit the form directly to the Department of Health.
6. Declaration Working Toward Licensure: Declare that you are working toward licensure as a Marriage and Family Therapist.

7. Applicant's Attestation:
You must sign and date this for us to process the application.

We appreciate your interest in obtaining a credential. You will be notified in writing if further documentation is required. If your application is incomplete, you will be contacted regarding the deficiencies.

- The application is considered incomplete if requested information is left blank.
 Put N/A or place a line through a section instead of leaving it blank.
- You must keep your address up to date in order to receive a courtesy renewal notice. Any renewal postmarked or presented to the department after midnight on the expiration date is late.


For Spouses and Registered Domestic Partners of Military Personnel Being Transferred or Stationed in Washington:

Under state law, if you are the spouse or state-registered domestic partner of a servicemember of any branch of the U.S. Military, to include Guard or Reserve, and are applying for a health care professional credential in this state, you may be eligible to have the processing of your application expedited to receive your credential more quickly.

Documents to submit with your application should include the following:

- A copy of your spouse's or registered domestic partner's military transfer orders to Washington State.
- One of the following:
 - A copy of your marriage certificate to show proof of marriage; or

A copy of a state's declaration or registration showing you are in a state registered domestic partnership with a member of the U.S. military.

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4. Educational Qualifications—Non COAMFTE Accredited Programs

You must have a masters or doctoral degree in marriage and family therapy or a behavorial science masters or doctoral degree with equivalent course work to apply. If any course listed does not specify clearly in its title the nature and content, provide an official syllabus, official course outline, or statement from the professor.

The equivalent course of graduate study must include courses in marital and family therapy, individual development, psychopathology, human sexuality, research, professional ethics and law, supervised clinical practice, and electives. A total of forty-five semester credits or sixty quarter credits are required. A minimum of twenty-seven semester credits or thirty-six quarter credits are required in the first six areas of study: Marital and Family Systems, Marital and Family Therapy, Individual Development, Psychopathology, Human Sexuality, and Research.

Approved Supervisor Declaration for Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist Candidates

To the Supervisor:

Please review <u>WAC 246-809-134</u>. To supervise a license candidate, you must hold a license without restrictions that has been in good standing for at least two years.

You must not be a blood or legal relative or cohabitant of the licensed candidate, licensed candidate's peer, or someone who has acted as the licensed candidate's therapist within the past two years.

Prior to the commencement of any supervision you must provide the licensed candidate a declaration, stating that you have met the requirements of <u>WAC 246-809-134</u> and you qualify as an approved supervisor if hours were gained in Washington State.


As an approved supervisor, I attest I have completed the following:

- A minimum of fifteen clock hours of training in clinical supervision obtained through:
 - A supervision course; or
 - Continuing education credits on supervision; or
 - Supervision of supervision; or
 - Or any combination of these; and
- Twenty-five hours of experience in supervision of clinical practice; or
- An American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) approved supervisor is considered to have met the qualifications above. Please submit proof of AAMFT approval.
